WHERE

WHEN

Friday from 4:00pm to 7:00pm Saturday from 6:30am to 10:00am

WHAT

Your packet contains the most important item for the run — your bib — along with other race goodies. Be sure to write your In Case of Emergency contact name and number on the back of your bib. T-shirts may be picked up at the t-shirt station.

WHO

Packets may be picked up by you or a friend and/or family member.

HOWEVER, you need to PLEASE be sure that both you and your friend are aware that the other has picked up the packet. We often have people arrive assuming their packets are missing when a friend has already picked it up.

If you registered after midnight on Sunday, April 4, please proceed to pick up your packet at Race Day Registration. Follow the signs or ask a volunteer in a MINT GREEN race day shirt where to go.

Give yourself enough time to park at the Washington County Fairgrounds, pick up your packet, prepare and stretch! Please see schedule on next page for start times and packet pickup. Remember to allow for race day traffic and early morning jitters.
